BESHREW: to curse

BOGGLER: a person who hesitates

ENGILDS: to make bright with light

EYNE: eyes

GALLOWGLASSES: followers or soldiers
owing allegiance to an Irish chief

GLEEK: to make a joke; jest

HAUTBOYS: oboes

HUGGER-MUGGER: of a confused or
disorderly nature

HURLY-BURLY: tumult or uproar

LANTHORN: lantern

LIMBECK: a vessel used in
distilling

MARTLET: a small bird of the
swallow family; also called
a martin

MISPRISED: to despise or
scorn

MORRIS: a vigorous English
dance traditionally
performed by men wearing
costumes and bells

MURRION: infected with or
killed by pestilence or
plague

NEAF: the fist

OPPUGNANCY:
antagonistically

PIGNUT: hickory nut

PRABBLE: quarrel or squabble

RERE-MICE: a bat

RONYON: a mangy or scabby creature

SKIMBLE SKAMBLE: rambling and
confused

TRUEPENNY: a trusty person

VAWARD: forefront

VOTARESS: a woman that is a devotee
